



Information for Students Wishing to Enrol for Level 3 Veterinary Equine Nursing Diploma

Entry requirements

- Minimum age - 18 years
- Applicant must be employed full time (30 hours per week or more) in an approved training and assessment practice (TP)
- Applicant must have passes in 5 GCSE subjects at (Grade C/ level 5 or higher) including one science, mathematics and English language
- Equivalent examinations will be accepted if at the correct level
- All qualification certificates **MUST** be submitted in **ENGLISH**
- All students will be required to provide the school with two forms of ID before enrolment (e.g. passport, driving licence)
- Applicant will require good access to the internet at home for private study/revision and at work for the completion of the nursing progress log

Expectation of Students

College attendance

Students will be expected to complete the course with an attendance record of no lower than 90%. Students will be required to be physically present at The Liphook Equine Hospital by for a 9 am start and return promptly from break and lunch.

Assignments

Students will be given at least four weeks to complete each assignment. Over those four weeks, the assignment should take priority over revision. Students may hand in a draft copy of the assignment up to 2 weeks before the assignment is due in.

Assignments **must** be handed in on time, assignments not handed in on the due date will be counted as a fail.

Revision

All students will be expected to prepare for their examinations in an organised and timely manner. This means that students are expected to revise for between 2-3 hours per week on top their other college and work commitments.

Record of Training

Students will be required to keep a clear record of the hours you work in practice from the date of your RCVS registration and any holiday and sick leave you take. This information will need to be recorded on the RCVS training record card needs to be sent to the RCVS once all examinations and assignments are completed.
